Beginning Stained Glass Class Information

Thank you for your interest in our stained glass classes. We offer the largest supply of stained glass tools, supplies, and art glass in the state. The classes we offer are very informative, and hands on. We pride ourselves on the quality of education you'll receive during any of our classes.

Our beginning stained glass class is just that, a class for beginners. This class is perfect for anyone age 16 and over who is interested in learning this exciting art. Even if you have some glass cutting or soldering experience, but have never completed a stained glass project, this class is for you as well. We teach all the basics and will help to address bad habits along the way.

This class is a total of three nights over three weeks (one night a week from 5:30 pm - 8:00 pm). The non-refundable class fee is \$45, and is required to reserve your spot in the class. As part of this class fee, we provide some materials and the glass for your first project. **All tools and any other supplies or glass you wish to use will be available for purchase throughout each night.** A list of suggested and required tools/supplies is attached to this sheet for reference. The basic beginning kit does not contain a grinder because all our classes include the use of our glass grinders. If you do have your own grinder, please do not bring it.

We strongly recommend that each person in the class have their own set of tools. Sharing tools is allowed, but will significantly hinder your ability to keep up with the pace of the class. Furthermore, we encourage all students to acquire the suggested and required tools/supplies prior to the beginning of the class (use your class time to learn, not buy tools). This can be done during our regular business hours. ****Please note**** - although we encourage you to purchase your tools beforehand, we suggest that you wait until the first night of class has **started** to open or use any tools. The instructor may make case by case suggestions on upgrades or alterations based on student ability or goals. Opened and/or used items are not exchangeable.

During each class, please note that all students will be required to wear safety glasses (also available for purchase). Students must wear closed-toe shoes to prevent injury. Furthermore, we suggest wearing shorter sleeved shirts throughout the year (bring a jacket when it's cold out).

Classes cannot be made up. We will make our best effort to get you all the missed information should you happen to miss a class, but we cannot repeat a class night for one person, as it would delay the rest of the class from moving ahead. For the beginning class, the first and second nights are paramount to your success. If you will not be able to attend one of these nights, you should postpone your class until the next set is offered. Please be aware that class fees cannot be refunded or transferred within 14 days of the first night of class, or any time after the class has started.

From our twenty years of teaching experience, we have found that when all beginning students move at the same pace for the first project (first two nights), there is a much higher success rate for everyone in the class. In all practical applications, this means we discourage students from attempting to complete and/or start new projects on their own, or between class nights. For example, please don't watch Youtube videos on how to solder your project, do it at home, and then expect perfect results. You are here for a class, please let us teach you in person. This, and practice, is the best way to learn. The beginning class is meant to only teach basics from start to finish and get you going on your own project on the third class night. For students who wish to make larger or more unique projects, we strongly encourage you to take the next class from us. It is typically a five week class (one night a week), and is geared toward assisting people with their own projects while adding to your knowledge base.
