Intro to Glass Fusing Class Information

Thank you for your interest in our fusing class. We offer the largest supply of fusing and stained glass tools, supplies, and art glass in the state. The classes we offer are very informative and hands on. We pride ourselves on the quality of education you'll receive during any of our classes.

This class is a total of two mornings from 9:00 to Noon. Students will need to bring the first day's projects back to our shop within one week of the class start date. On the second class day, each student will make additional pieces to fuse and bring them back to our shop by a date determined during the class. To summarize, this **class meets two days** over a total of two weeks.

The non-refundable class fee is \$100, and is required to reserve your spot in the class. As part of this class fee, all students will receive a supply of fusible glass to be used during the class. There will also be additional supplies free to use during the class. This class fee also includes two separate kiln firings. We also allow all students unlimited use of our grinders and glass saw during class hours. All tools and any other supplies or glass you wish to use will be available for purchase throughout each class. At the end of this class, each student will have had the opportunity to make at least 12 pendants or similar sized items.

Our Intro to glass fusing is just that, an introductory to the art and basic techniques. In this class, you will learn all the basics of glass firing, kiln prep, glass prep, etc. This class does NOT focus on the basics of glass cutting. If you have never cut glass, or are unsure of your skill level, please let us know this when you sign up for the class so we can leave adequate time to teach you this part. Not knowing how to cut glass **DOES NOT** exclude you from this class.

You are welcome to bring any and all tools you have, but the only required tools for this class are a glass cutter, glass breaking pliers, and safety glasses. Sharing tools is allowed, but may significantly hinder your ability to keep up with the pace of the class. Furthermore, we encourage all students to acquire the suggested and required tools/supplies prior to the beginning of the class (use your class time to learn, not buy tools/glass/etc). This can be done during our regular business hours.

During each class, please note that all students will be required to wear safety glasses at all times, please bring your own. Students must wear closed-toe shoes to prevent injury. Furthermore, we suggest wearing shorter sleeved shirts throughout the year (bring a jacket when it's cold out).

Classes cannot be made up. We will make our best effort to get you all the missed information should you happen to miss a class, but we cannot repeat a class night for one person, as it would delay the rest of the class from moving ahead. Please be aware that class fees cannot be transferred within 14 days of the first day of class, or any time after the class has started.
